Hello Fall faculty,

You are receiving this email because you or your department have chosen to use Immediate Access digital course materials for the upcoming Fall term. Your title was enrolled into the Immediate Access Program based on how you or your department coordinator adopted the title into our online book adoption portal; or you emailed us directly that you wished to use Immediate Access.

Please make sure to complete the following action items:

- **Confirm Fall term digital course material** - Attached is the “Fall 2024 Immediate Access Titles for Faculty Review” spreadsheet. This is a list of all the confirmed courses that require Immediate Access for the upcoming Fall term. Please find your course(s) and section(s) and check the title to make sure we have the correct title listed. Please let me know as soon as possible if any of the information related to the title that is listed for the course is not correct to avoid technical setup issues. If everything looks correct you do not need to email me back.

Undergraduate courses (4999 and below) are now in our **Immediate Access ONE program**. If you are not yet familiar with Immediate Access ONE, this is a program where undergraduate students receive required digital and print course materials for a \$259 per semester flat fee. Digital titles can be accessed on the first day of class through Canvas. Students can opt out within the first ten days of class and receive a refund. Graduate courses (5000 and above) will use the traditional Immediate Access we have used in the past where students receive digital access to the required titles the first day of class through Canvas. Students are billed individually for each title and can choose to opt out by title.

Some sections may have “STAFF” listed as we import whatever information for instructor is listed in Workday at that time.

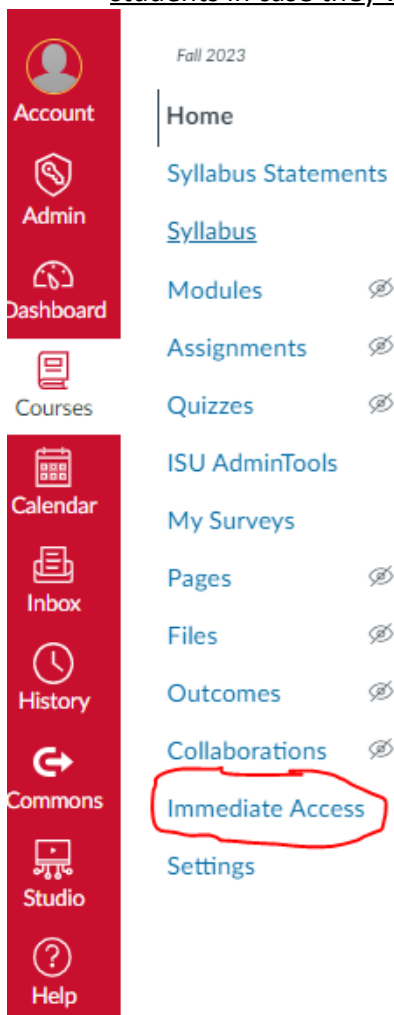
This isn't a final list as we are still receiving adoptions (course material orders) from faculty and departmental coordinators.

If you are using Packback please make sure we have the correct one listed. There are three types of Packback: **Packback Questions with Instruct**, **Packback Deep Dives with Instruct**, and the **bundle that includes the Questions, Instruct and Deep Dives**.

### Locating the Immediate Access link -

The Immediate Access is a global link and will automatically be on your Canvas navigation menu. You do not have to add and enable it manually.

IMPORTANT! Please do not remove the link. It is used by students to either access their ebooks, access Pearson's MyLab and Mastering courseware, or includes instructions on how to access other publisher courseware. The link is also used by students in case they wish to opt out of the program.



If this link is not on your Canvas Navigation Menu please let me know.

After you click on the Immediate Access link, don't be alarmed if you see "0 Materials" or "You currently have no materials associated with this course". This is normal for this time of year as we are still "prepping" the digital content on our end with VitalSource by adding
